Dear Parents

As you may be aware, the Victorian government has just announced a snap 7 day lockdown beginning at 11.59pm tonight. This lockdown includes the closing of schools in Melbourne, therefore the students of St Peter Apostle will be returning to remote learning as of Friday the 28th May (tomorrow) until Thursday the 3rd June, unless the lockdown is lifted earlier. To support our community through this lockdown, the following has been put into place:

- All students have been sent home today with a pack that contains five days of work. Each pack has a timetable with Days 1 - 5 clearly labelled and an explanation of what needs to be done for that day. All required resources are included in the pack.
- Families that do not have access to a computer can borrow one from the school. These can be picked up from the office when you pick your child up from school today.
- Onsite supervision is available for families that fit the government criteria. An Operoo note will be sent home today for families to apply for this.

The professional development organised for our school closure day on Monday the 31st May has been postponed due to the lockdown and students have now been provided with work for this day. This means that our school closure day has been postponed.

Further information will be sent home to families in the coming days. Thank you for your continued support in keeping our community safe.

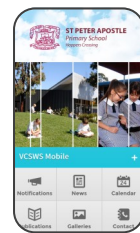

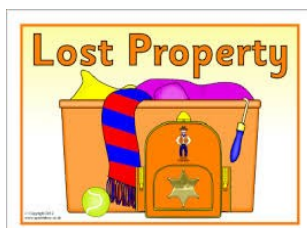

Late Arrivals & Early Dismissals

If you need to pick your child up during the day due to an appointment, could you please send a note with your child stating the time he/she will be picked up so that your child can be ready at the office when you arrive.

Medications

It is the policy at St. Peter's that staff members are unable to administer any medication to a child without the parent's written authorisation.

No child is to carry medication on them, unless it is for Asthma. If a child is to be given any medication, parents must report to the office to complete a medical management consent form prior to commencement of administering medication. All medication will be administered around 12 noon.

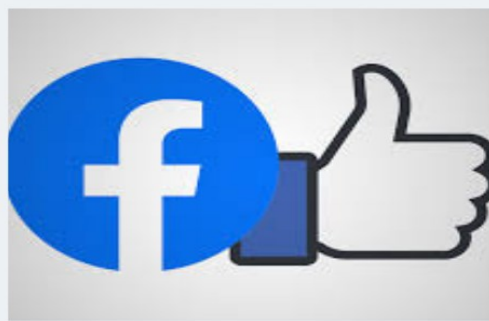
