

Year 5 participated in a STEM program run by Akron Education Services. This program is based on the Catholic Social teachings and Pope Francis' message in Laudato Si; 'The spirit of life dwells in every living creature and calls us to enter into a relationship with him.'

The students were asked to design a portable shelter that could be transported as a flat pack and easily assembled. This challenged the students' thinking as well as their mathematical knowledge and design skills. They created some unique and strong designs.

The second challenge was to design an item that would assist someone with a disability. The students collaborated and designed items to meet the needs of a specific disability and began ideating how this item or service would look, be distributed or accessed by them.


