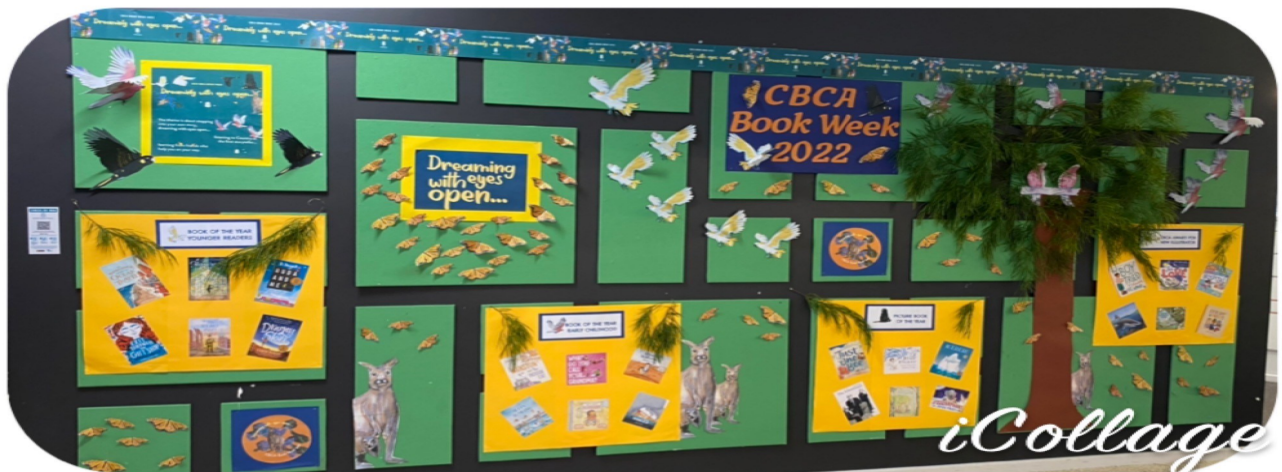
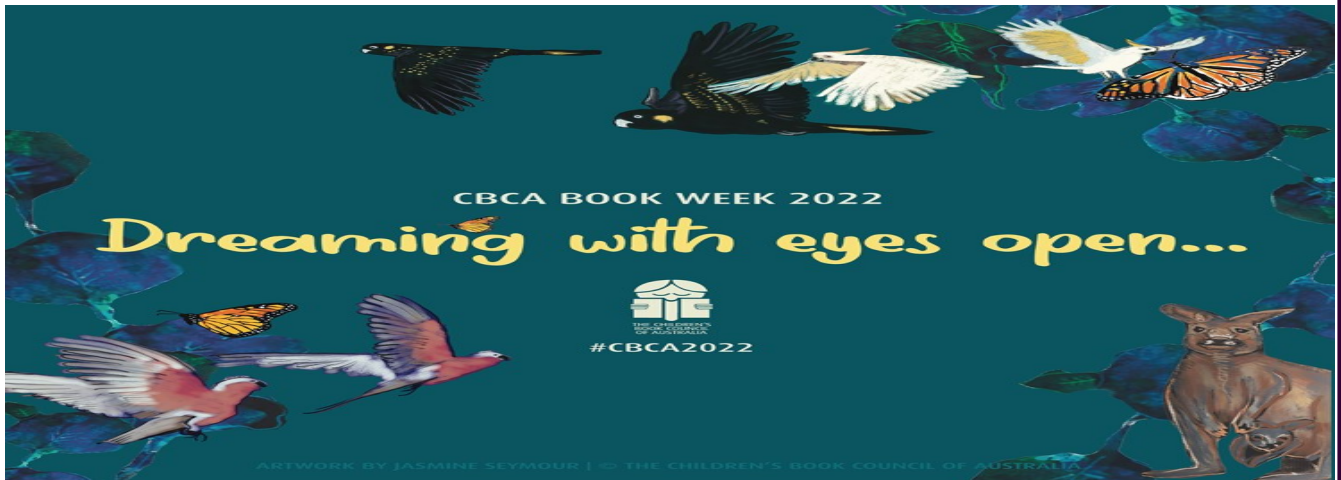

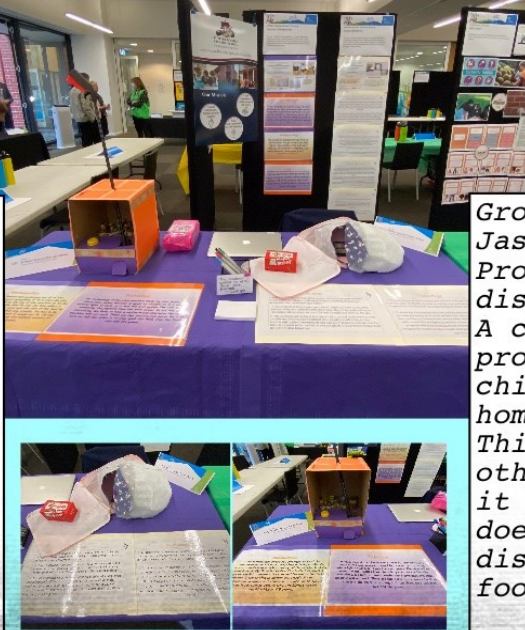


After participating in the STEM program run by Akorn Educational Services in Term 2, the Year 5 students were given the challenge based on the Catholic Social teachings of Pope Francis' message in Laudato Si; 'The spirit of life dwells in every living creature and calls us to enter into a relationship with him.' They brainstormed and designed a product to assist a group or community in need. Two projects were selected to attend the Melbourne Archdioceses STEM MAD Showcase on August 4th. Competing against 100 projects on the day, their projects drew plenty of attention. Special credit was given to both groups for presenting their projects via videoconference showing the high standard of work completed. Judging of the Primary school category awarded Group 1 with an award for the mathematical research involved in their design. Group 1 has now been invited to attend the National STEM MAD showcase on the 31st August via videoconference and 6th September at the Catholic Education Conference held at the Melbourne Conference and Exhibition Centre. Congratulations to Elisha, Emerald, Jane, Jasmyn, Lucia, Maddison, Naomi, Sharleen and Willow in Year 5.



Group 1: Jane, Lucia, Maddison & Naomi
Product: Cormadome safe.

A safety tent designed to self-inflate, providing shelter for children experiencing threats from violence, that incorporates a device to help children keep calm and contacts emergency services.



Group 2: Elisha, Emerald, Jasmine, Sharleen & Willow
Product: Food claw dispenser.

A claw game designed to provide engagement of children experiencing homelessness or in need. This game operates like other claw games although it is solar powered, doesn't require money and dispenses non-perishable foods.

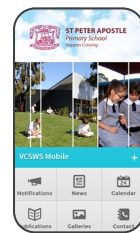

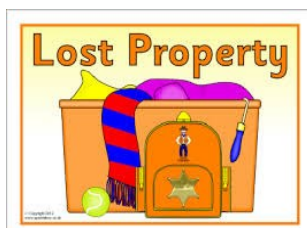
